

3. Boat trip to Zuiderklip Observatory Tower (Coordinates: 51.116605, 4.416964)



Zuiderklip Observatory Tower is situated in the heart of the Biesbosch. You can reach it by boat or canoe, or on a (boat) excursion from the visitor centre in Drimmelen. From the mooring place Zuiderklip you can hike over the dike of the wetland. Spoonbills and other waders in summer, foraging geese in winter, good place for Osprey during migration.
